CELEBRATION OF HOLY COMMUNION

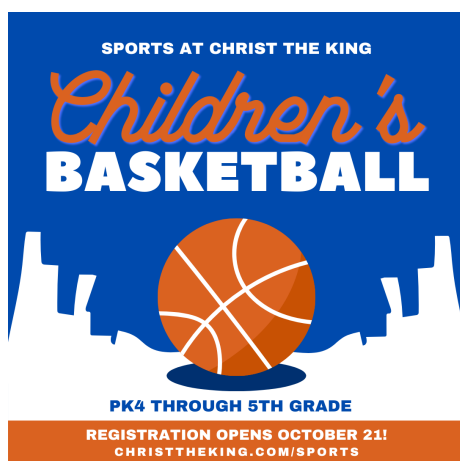
